RESOLUTION NO. 2016-19

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2016 GREAT UTAH SHAKEOUT

WHEREAS, the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) recognizes that no community is immune from natural hazards such as earthquake, wildfire, flood, severe storms or heat wave, and recognizes the importance of enhancing its ability to withstand natural hazards and of reducing the human suffering, property damage, interruption of public services and economic losses caused by those hazards; and

WHEREAS, major earthquakes pose a particular, significant and ongoing threat to the City and all of the Wasatch Front region; and

WHEREAS, community resiliency to earthquakes and other disasters depends on the preparedness levels of all stakeholders in the community – individuals, families, schools, community organizations, faith-based organizations, non-profits, businesses, and government; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote earthquake preparedness for itself internally and for its residents, and to plan appropriately for earthquake-related disasters; and

WHEREAS, by participating in “The Great Utah Shakeout” on 16 April 2016, the City has the opportunity to join and support all Utahns in strengthening community and regional resiliency, including by utilizing the provided information to educate its staff and its residents regarding actions to protect life and property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cottonwood Heights city council that the City’s participation in “The Great Utah Shakeout” on 16 April 2016 is hereby advised and approved for the purposes of building a safer community and reducing the loss of lives and property from a major earthquake through education and proactive steps.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2016-19, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
