





Fireworks Safety

Each Year Fireworks Cause:

An estimated **15,000** fires, including:

1,000 structural fires



300 vehicle fires

8,600 trips to the Emergency Room



Sparklers can reach temperatures of more than **2,000** degrees F.

Safety Tips

- » Be aware of **local & state laws** regarding fireworks
- » NEVER let children **play with or light** fireworks
- » ALWAYS stay a **safe distance** away from fireworks
- » Keep **water or a hose nearby** in case of accidents
- » NEVER try to relight **malfunctioning** fireworks
- » NEVER point fireworks at **yourself or others**
- » ALWAYS **fully douse** spent fireworks before **safely discarding**
