RESOLUTION No. 2019-50

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH SALT LAKE CITY FOR THE EAST JORDAN CANAL TRAIL

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. §11-13-101, *et seq.* (the “*Interlocal Cooperation Act*”) provides that any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action following the adoption of an appropriate resolution by the governing body of each participating public agency; and

WHEREAS, Salt Lake City (“*SLC*”) owns certain real property located in the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”) that contains the East Jordan Canal Extension (the “*Canal*”); and

WHEREAS, the Canal is covered, and the City desires to install a public trail surface and other above-ground improvements on the Canal for recreational use (the “*Trail*”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in the Interlocal Cooperation Act, SLC and the City (both of which are public agencies for purposes of the Interlocal Cooperation Act) desire to enter into an “interlocal agreement” (the “*Agreement*”) whereunder SLC will authorize the City to install and use the public Trail on the Canal, on the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City’s city council (the “*Council*”) met in regular session on 3 September 2019 to consider, among other things, approving the City’s entry into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the form of the Agreement, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, the city attorney of the City has approved the form of the Agreement as required by *Utah Code Ann.* §11-13-202.5(3); and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City’s residents to approve the City’s entry into the Agreement as proposed in order to make efficient use of the City’s resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Agreement with SLC is hereby approved, together with such modifications thereto as may be deemed appropriate by the City’s mayor and manager in consultation with the City’s attorney, and that the City’s mayor and recorder are authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of the City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2019-50, shall take effect immediately upon passage.


