## DECLARATION NO. 2019-02

### A DECLARATION OF THE COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS BOARD OF CANVASSERS APPROVING THE CANVASS OF THE 2019 COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**WHEREAS**, on 5 November 2019, the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”) held a municipal general election (the “*Election*”); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(a), the City’s mayor and municipal legislative body comprise the City’s board of municipal canvassers (the “*Board*”) for the Election; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(b), the Board is required to meet to canvass the returns of the Election at the usual place of meeting of the City’s municipal legislative body no sooner than seven days and no later than 14 days after the Election; and

**WHEREAS**, on 19 November 2019, the Board met in the meeting room of the City’s city council (the “*Council*”) for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the Election; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that the Election, and the voting therein, were conducted in compliance with Utah state law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED** by the board of municipal canvassers of the city of Cottonwood Heights as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts and approves the conduct and results of the Election.

Section 2. The following candidates, resolutions and questions are declared and certified to have received the number of votes indicated:

Section 3. The following two candidates, having qualified by number of votes, are hereby declared elected as members of the Council for the following terms of office:

Douglas Petersen	Council Member–District 1	Four year term
Scott Bracken	Council Member–District 2	Four year term

Section 4. The City’s city recorder (the “Recorder”), as its election officer, shall furnish a certified copy of this declaration (this “Declaration”) and a certified copy of the results of the Election to the office of the Lt. Governor of the state of Utah on or before the statutory deadline for such submissions.

Section 5. Attached as an exhibit hereto is a report containing the information required by UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-304(2) (the “Report”). Each member of the Board has reviewed the Report to ensure that it is correct, and by his affirmative vote below, authorizes and directs the City’s mayor and recorder to sign, record, publish and file the Report as required by UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(c).

Section 6. By her signature below, the Recorder, as the City’s election officer, also certifies that the information contained in the Report is accurate.

This Declaration, assigned no. 2019-02, shall take effect immediately upon passage.


