ORDINANCE NO. 334

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.80 OF THE COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING TANDEM PARKING

WHEREAS, the “Municipal Land Use, Development, and Management Act,” UTAH CODE ANN. §10-9a-101 *et seq.*, as amended (the “Act”), provides that each municipality may enact a land use ordinance and a zoning map establishing regulations for land use and development; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the municipality’s planning commission shall prepare and recommend to the municipality’s legislative body, following a public hearing, a proposed land use ordinance and a zoning map, or amendments thereto, that represents the planning commission’s recommendations for zoning the area within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Act also provides certain procedures for the municipality’s legislative body to adopt or amend the land use ordinance and zoning map for the City; and

WHEREAS, on 14 July 2005, the legislative body (the “Council”) of the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) enacted its Ordinance No. 25 adopting a land use ordinance for the City and codifying such ordinance as Title 19 of the City’s code of ordinances (the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, thereafter, the City’s planning commission (the “Planning Commission”) formulated proposed amendments (the “Amendments”) to Chapter 19.80 of the Code concerning off-street parking requirements in the City; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Planning Commission where citizens were given the opportunity to provide written or oral comment concerning the proposed Amendments; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing before the Planning Commission was preceded by all required legal notices; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Planning Commission recommended the Amendments to the Council for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Council subsequently took additional public comment concerning the Amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed and is familiar with the Amendments, a copy of which is annexed as an exhibit to this ordinance, including any amendments proposed by the Council to the form of the Amendments recommended for adoption by the Planning Commission, as authorized by UTAH CODE ANN. 10-9a-502(2); and

WHEREAS, on 3 December 2019, the Council met in regular meeting to consider, among other things, amending the Code to enact the Amendments, including any such revisions; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Planning Commission, comments at the public hearing and other public meetings, and other relevant input, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to adopt and enact the Amendments as proposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Amendments. The Council hereby adopts and enacts the Amendments in the form of the attached exhibit.

Section 2. Action of Officers. All actions of the officers, agents and employees of the City that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Ordinance No. 334 (this "Ordinance"), whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 3. Severability. It is hereby declared that all parts of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance, assigned no. 334, shall take immediate effect as soon as it shall be published or posted as required by law and deposited and recorded in the office of the City's Recorder, or such later date as may be required by Utah statute.



EXHIBIT TO ORDINANCE NO. 334

19.80.060 Dimensions for parking stalls.

A. The dimensions of parking stalls and aisles contained within the parking areas shall be dependent upon the orientation of stalls. The table titled "Dimensions for Parking Stalls and Aisles" under section ~~19.80.120~~ 19.80.130 details these standards, and any deviation to these standards must be recommended by the city engineer and approved by the planning commission.

B. Tandem parking spaces are allowed, provided that in all uses other than single family residences, only the space with direct access to the driveway or street shall count toward meeting the minimum parking requirements under section 19.80.120. "Tandem parking spaces" means the placement of parking spaces one behind the other, so that the space nearest the driveway or street access serves as the only means of access to the other space.

19.80.070 Handicapped accessible parking.

A. Handicapped parking stalls shall be provided in off-street parking areas and shall Count towards fulfilling the minimum requirements for automobile parking.

B. Handicapped parking stalls shall be located as near as practical to a primary building entrance with access ramps negotiable for equipment used in assisting handicapped persons. A permanently affixed reflective sign and/or surface identification painting depicting the standard symbol for handicapped parking shall identify each parking stall.

C. The number of handicapped parking stalls shall conform to the minimum requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the table detailed in section ~~19.80.120~~ 19.80.130.

D. The dimensions of handicapped parking stalls shall be thirteen (13) feet by twenty (20) feet or such standard as may be required by the ADA.
