## RESOLUTION No. 2020-24

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING ENTRY INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH SALT LAKE COUNTY AND OTHERS FOR MAINTENANCE OF “PARK AND RIDE” LOTS

**WHEREAS**, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, UTAH CODE ANN. §11-13-101 *et. seq.* (the “*Interlocal Cooperation Act*”), provides that any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action following the adoption of an appropriate resolution by the governing body of each participating public agency; and

**WHEREAS**, Salt Lake County (the “*County*”), Utah Department of Transportation (“*UDOT*”), Utah Transit Authority (“*UTA*”), and the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”) are public agencies for purposes of the Interlocal Cooperation Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has presented for the City’s review and approval an interlocal cooperation agreement (the “*Agreement*”) among the City, the County, UDOT, UTA and others concerning the continued maintenance of “park and ride” facilities located at 3815 East Big Cottonwood Canyon Road in the City, 8101 South 3500 East in the City, and 4385 East Little Cottonwood Canyon Road in Sandy (collectively, the “*Lots*”), whereunder each of the parties will provide services, funding, or both, to maintain the Lots, on the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s city council (the “*Council*”) met in regular session on 2 June 2020 to consider, among other things, approving the City’s entry into the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has reviewed the form of the Agreement, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s city attorney has approved the form of the Agreement as required by UTAH CODE ANN. §11-13-202.5(3); and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City’s residents to approve the City’s entry into the Agreement as proposed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Agreement be, and hereby is, approved, and that the City’s mayor and recorder are authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of the City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2020-24, shall take effect immediately upon passage.


