The workshop is primarily on improv techniques, but parallels life skills that will also be taught in the workshop, such as developing relationships, communication skills, teamwork, trust & confidence. His target is 15-18 year olds, and adults.

The arts council discussed his proposal after he left, and decided the free workshop would make a great masterclass and added it to the schedule in October 2020.
