RESOLUTION NO. 2020-33

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A REQUEST FOR INDEMNIFICATION

WHEREAS, E. Robert Russo (“*Chief Russo*”), individually and in his capacity as the chief of police of the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”), has been served as a counterclaim defendant in an action styled *Ernest Robert Russo, Jr. vs. Cottonwood Heights, a City, Natalie C. Bruce, an individual, and John Doe Employees/Agents 1-10* that currently is pending as case no. 200903436 in the Third District Court of Salt Lake County, Utah (including any removal or appeal of such case to another court, the “*Lawsuit*”); and

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. §63G-7-902, a portion of the Governmental Immunity Act of Utah (the “*Act*”), provides that a governmental entity shall defend any action brought against its employees arising from an act or omission occurring (a) during the performance of the employee’s duties; (b) within the scope of the employee’s employment; or (c) under color of authority; and

WHEREAS, Chief Russo has filed a request for indemnification (the “*Request*”) with the City as required by UTAH CODE ANN. §63G-7-902(2); and

WHEREAS, the Council met in regular session on 7 July 2020 to consider, among other things, granting the Request; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to grant the Request and, by so doing, to agree to defend and indemnify Chief Russo for any judgment, compromise or settlement of claim based on the acts and conduct specified in the Lawsuit, but only to the extent that such acts and conduct occurred (a) during the performance of Chief Russo’s duties; (b) within the scope of Chief Russo’s employment; or (c) under color of authority, with a reservation of rights by the City as provided in UTAH CODE ANN. §63G-7-902(6);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cottonwood Heights city council that the City hereby grants the Request and hereby agrees to defend and indemnify Chief Russo for any judgment, compromise or settlement of claim based on the acts or conduct specified in the Lawsuit, but only to the extent that such acts and conduct occurred (a) during the performance of Chief Russo’s duties; (b) within the scope of Chief Russo’s employment; or (c) under color of authority, with a reservation of rights by the City as provided in UTAH CODE ANN. §63G-7-902(6).


This Resolution, assigned no. 2020-33, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
